statement supporting a group of ministers from that city who had been arrested in Jackson. There were Black and white

ministers in this delegation to Mississippi. Dr Laird said:

Some might raise the question as to the propriety of ministers from the North carrying on a crusade for justice in the Suuth. This is a legitimate question and deserves an answer.

. . .

Whatever goes on in one part of the (American) union *fo* is of concern to the whole nation. Any American's concern about what takes place in another section of the country is a justifiable concern.

Sickness in one part of the country can spread through the rest of the land. The denial of freedom anywhere is a threat to freedom elsewhere.
