The search for a meaningful theology was one of the important aspects of the Lawrence Conference, stimulated by platform speakers, discussion, and Bible study groups.

The dominant theological position at the Conference was

Neo-Orthodoxy and the so called "New Theology" instead of the Liberalism to which Millsaps students are accustomed.

Dr. Edmund Perry, Neo-Orthodox, wrote Confessing the Gospel Mark Preached used by all at the Conference. On various subjects he writes that we must believe in Satan as the personal head of the kingdom of evil and sin because Jesus believed this. On miracles, he says, "If miracles are a problem for our faith, they are a problem only because our view of God has been determined by disregard of the Bible. We cannot reject the miracles of Jesus without thereby rejecting the Gospel." A firm believer in the necessity of Apostolic Succession, he calls for Methodism to return to the Catholic tradition, "...there is no Scriptural authority for the Methodist Church to continue outside the communion of the Churches in Apostolic Succession.... Unless our Church originated in and continues in history from Christ and the Apostolic community, it is not Christ's Church according to the Scriptures."
