I would like to report and protest the failure of Jackson City Police and, especially, Capt. Ray in the <sup>fair</sup> performance of their duty and the protection of all citizens.

On Tuesday, May 11, 1963, a mob of white persons was attacking a group of Negro and white people at Woolworth's lunch counter. City police led by Capt. Ray stood outside the store and refused to do anything about the vicious mob.
